


ADULT SAFEGUARDING CHECKLIST

Safeguarding does not always have easy answers and every situation is different. Because of this, rather than being prescriptive the Department of Health gives us **6 safeguarding principles** which should always inform our approach and actions. When considering what actions to take, always check that you are working in line with the six principles:

**EMPOWERMENT
PREVENTION
PROPORTIONALITY
PROTECTION
PARTNERSHIP
ACCOUNTABILITY**
